

Mains-failure GSM Alarm

Operates on the mobile network

A remarkably versatile little unit. This dialler needs no landline or even mains power, and can communicate with up to five mobile or landline phones by text message and / or voice call and immediately report a problem, be it security, process control or power-failure.

Enhanced security features include password protection on all commands and incoming call filtering.

It also boasts a remotely controlled output that can be used to arm and disarm an alarm system, trigger a siren, activate a CCTV recording, switch on lighting, release a locked gate etc. simply by sending it a text message.

The dialler is ideal for temporary or permanent installation in remote properties with or without mains power, as it operates on a 12 volt supply. It will run happily for typically 2 months between charges.

By itself, with no extra equipment, it can be used as a GSM mains-failure alarm, to provide instant remote notification via text message if the mains power is interrupted. It will also let you know when power is restored.

When used with our **FarmGuard** perimeter protection system it will contact key-holders and a security patrol the instant the perimeter is breached, providing an extremely effective and economical security solution.
