



# QuadGuard

## Revolutionary ATV Protection System

Marvellous, aren't they, quad bikes. Jump on and you're away over the fields. Convenient and indispensable to you, but also a gift to thieves. There are a number of mechanical locks and such-like on the market to try to make life difficult for them. Unfortunately they also make yours a little less agreeable, and the temptation is to leave the thing unprotected if you're in a rush or you're only leaving it for a short period. Mechanical devices also have the drawback that they allow the thief to work at them for as long as he needs, undisturbed, without giving you any warning.

**QuadGuard** is a revolutionary new system that **stacks the odds firmly back in your favour**. It uses a combination of highly sensitive vibration and movement detectors connected to a miniature transmitter. The instant anyone starts to tamper with your ATV (or tractor, caravan, horsebox or trailer) a signal will be transmitted to a receiver up to half a mile away. Usually this would be located in your house, although it can easily be left in a farm office or workshop, or with a neighbour if you're away. The receiver's built-in buzzer or siren will warn you that an attempted theft is in progress. The transmitter can be silent, giving you the element of surprise, or equipped with a bleeper to warn the thief that he's been detected.

The system is armed and disarmed with a key. The sensor and transmitter can be fitted anywhere on the quad, usually tucked away out of sight.

### System components and extras shown below:



#### QG/Tx Vibration sensor / transmitter

Transmitting range - 400m (can be extended with antenna on receiver)  
Power source - Internal AA batteries (average life 2 years)  
Built-in buzzer (can be disabled if required)



#### QG/R1 Single-channel receiver / buzzer:

Built-in buzzer (90dB) or mini-siren (105dB)  
Receiving range - 400m with built-in antenna or 800m (line-of-sight) with whip antenna  
Power source - connects to mains



#### QG/R8 8-channel receiver:

Built-in sounder  
Receiving range - 400m with built-in antenna or 800m (line-of-sight) with whip antenna  
Power source - connects to mains. Battery back-up optional.  
Supplied pre-programmed. Provides visual indication of location of intrusion (8 separate zones). Low sensor-battery warning. Can be connected to siren and / or auto-dialler. Also has fire & panic channels.



#### Pocket Pager:

Transmitting range (from receiver) - 800m  
Power source - internal AAA batteries

Perfect to keep you alerted when you're out and about around the farm. The QuadGuard transmitter sends a signal to the receiver in the house, and from there the alarm is relayed to the pocket pager.
